Field: Up to 78 Players

Format of Play: 54 Hole Individual Stroke Play Competition

Eligibility:

Female amateur players of Asian nationality ages 13-18 at the time of the event (or born between January 1, 2008 and December 31, 2013), who are not yet in college. Participants will be invited or can apply. In the latter case, selection will be determined based on rankings, handicaps, and slot availability.

Yardage: 6,492 yards (measured to the center of the green)

Player Benefits:

The top 3 players and ties will receive an invitation to the Hilton Grand Vacations ANNIKA Invitational presented by Rolex in the United States in 2027, as well as a \$1,500 travel reimbursement for the event. If a qualifying player turns professional or enrolls in university after securing their spot, they will forfeit the right, and it will be offered to the next eligible player. If a rights-holder declines to participate in the world championship, the right will not be passed down to the next player.

World Amateur Golf Ranking: This event is a WAGR points eligible tournament.

Tournament Entry Fee: 35,000 Japanese Yen (yen)

Entry fee includes:

- Green fee, caddie fee, and golf cart fee during each tournament round.
- Two trays of range balls daily during tournament days (October 26 – 29).
- Round fee for the designated practice day on October 26.
- Breakfast and lunch (in lunch boxes) at the Golf Club (October 26 – 29).
- Annika-hosted golf clinic (October 26).
- Tournament Welcome Dinner (October 26).
- "More Than Golf with Baskin-Robbins Japan" co-hosted by ANNIKA Foundation and Baskin-Robbins Japan (October 27).
- One yardage book (to be provided at on-site registration).
- Tournament souvenir (tentative).

- * A refund will be issued if you withdraw from the competition with a doctor's note by September 25 (Fri). Please notify the Tournament Office (info@annika-br31.jp) by e-mail.
- * After the first entry period closes, we will contact the selected participants with further details in due course. Participants who receive this notification must complete the payment process within one week of receiving the message from the Tournament Office.
- * If all spots are filled during the first entry period, any players who were not accepted will be placed on a waiting list along with those who apply during the second entry period. Should any confirmed participants withdraw, spots will be offered to players on the waiting list in order of their position on the list. Therefore, we ask that any players contacted to participate complete the payment process promptly.

Official Practice Round (Monday, October 26)

Practice round is set to start at 8:30 am in a shot gun format. Please e-mail the Tournament Office (info@annika-br31.jp), if you decided to withdraw from the practice round. (Round fee is included in the Tournament Entry Fee.)

- * Pairings will be done by the Tournament side. It will be announced on October 25 (Sun) after 3:00 pm on the tournament website and will also be posted on the onsite information board.

Practice Round Before Tournament Week:

Practice round fees are as below;

Until end of September: 18,800 yen (includes caddie, cart, and tax)

October: 19,800 yen (includes caddie, cart, and tax)

- * Weekdays only.
- * The putting green and practice range will not be available for use on the Saturday and

Sunday immediately preceding the tournament (October 24 and 25).

* Reservations accepted per group only.

* For 2-somes, an additional caddie fee of 4,400 yen (tax included) per person will apply. For 3-somes, an additional caddie fee of 1,100 yen (tax included) per person will apply.

*The greens used may differ from those on the tournament days.

Distance Measuring Device:

Measuring devices are allowed but must be in non-slope mode (slope function not permitted).

Use of Caddies:

The use of a caddie and a golf cart is mandatory. Only caddies are permitted to operate the carts. Electric push carts are not permitted. Players must walk the course during the tournament. However, players may ride in carts during practice rounds.

Official Bus:

During the tournament period, transportation will be provided between the official hotel and the golf course. (Please check the shuttle bus schedule posted at the hotel or the course.)

Meals during Tournament Week:

The tournament entry fee includes breakfast and lunch boxes for 4 days, and one Welcome Dinner on the evening of October 26 (all provided at the course).

*Parents and guardians may use the restaurant; however, if it is crowded, please give priority to players. Please settle your bill on the spot.

*Breakfast at the golf course: 6:00 am – 9:30 am (Western buffet).

*Lunch: Boxed lunch will be provided to players daily during the tournament. Players should

pick them up at the starter's office at the turn. Parents and companions can purchase lunch; please buy a ticket at the front desk and proceed to the restaurant.

*Please note that there will be no breaks between the first and second half of the round.
